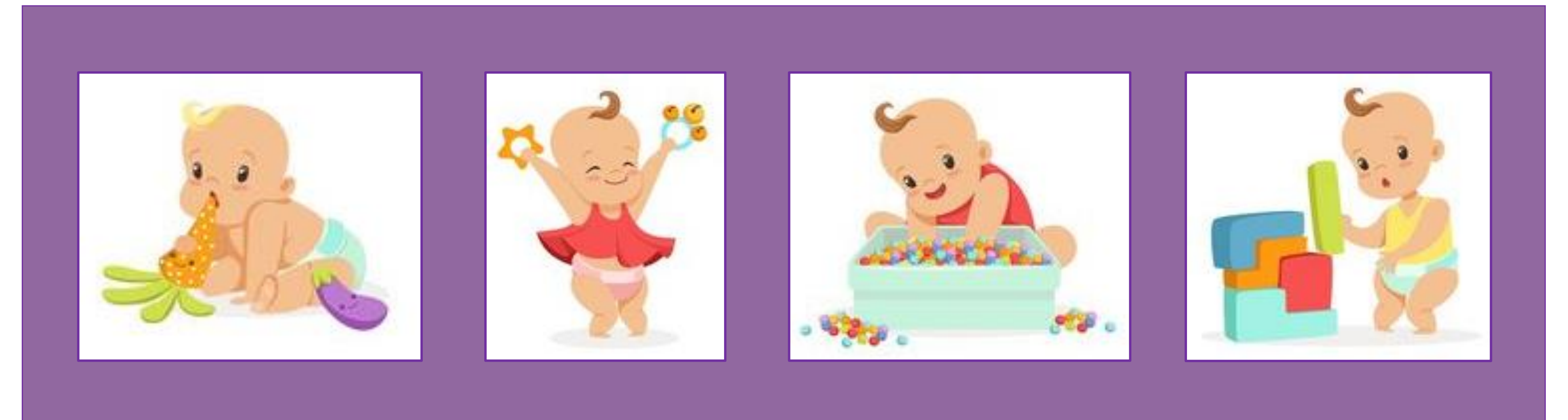


# The Infant Curiosity Questionnaire

The first measure of general infant curiosity

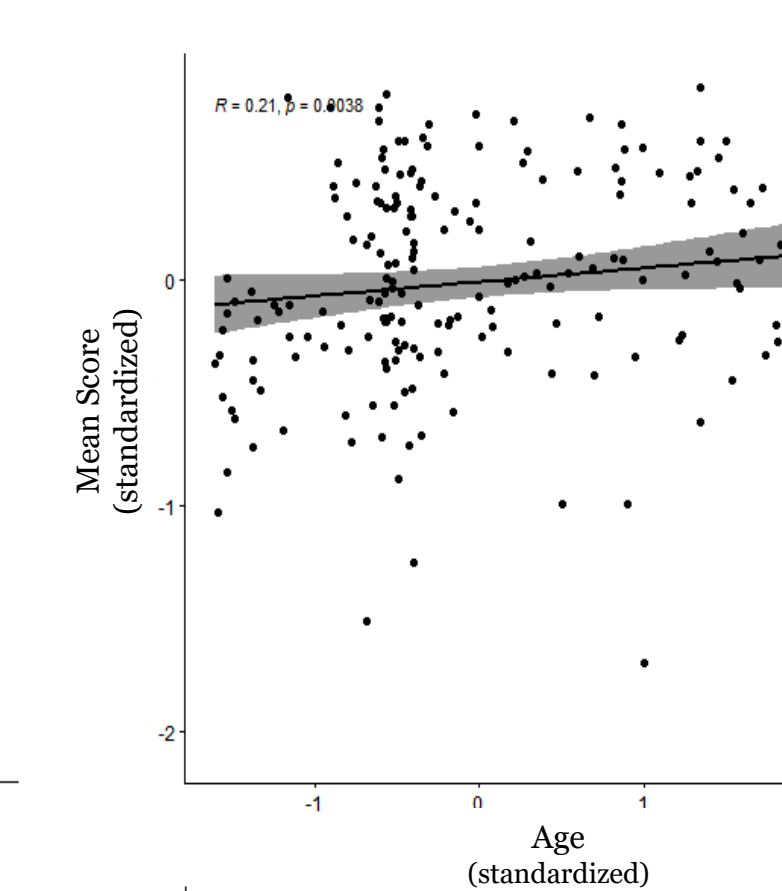
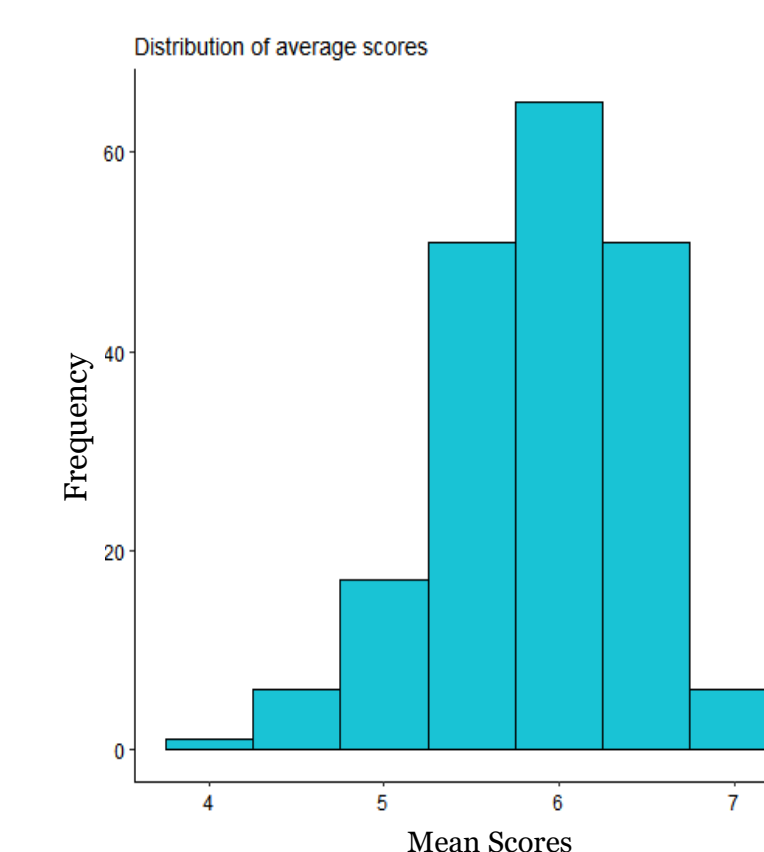
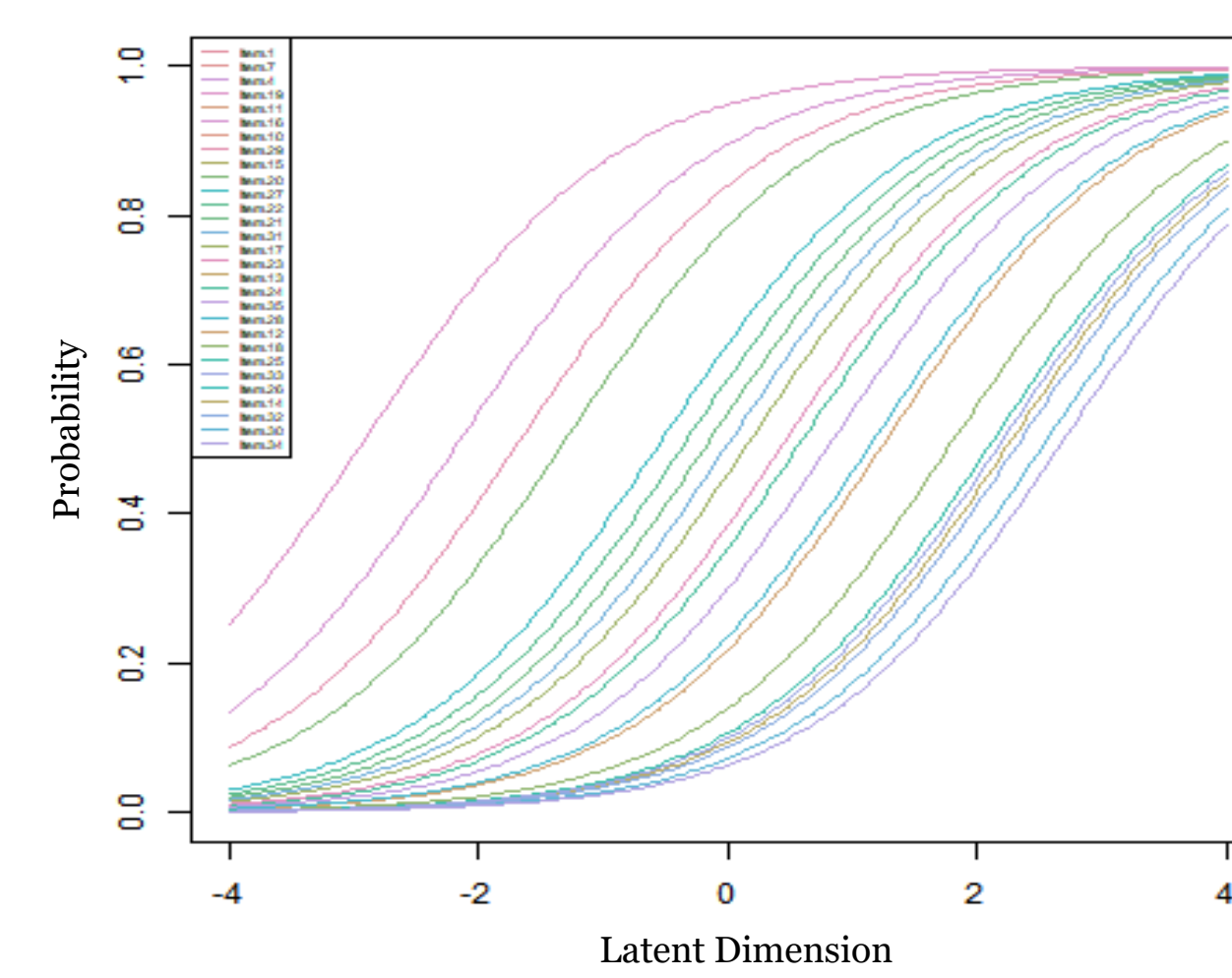
## 1. What's in it?

**Example Item:**  
When my child looks into a container (e.g., a bag, kitchen drawer, etc.), they take out and inspect each of its contents.



- 36 items on how infants & toddlers can interact with their environment in a curious manner, on a 7-point Likert Scale

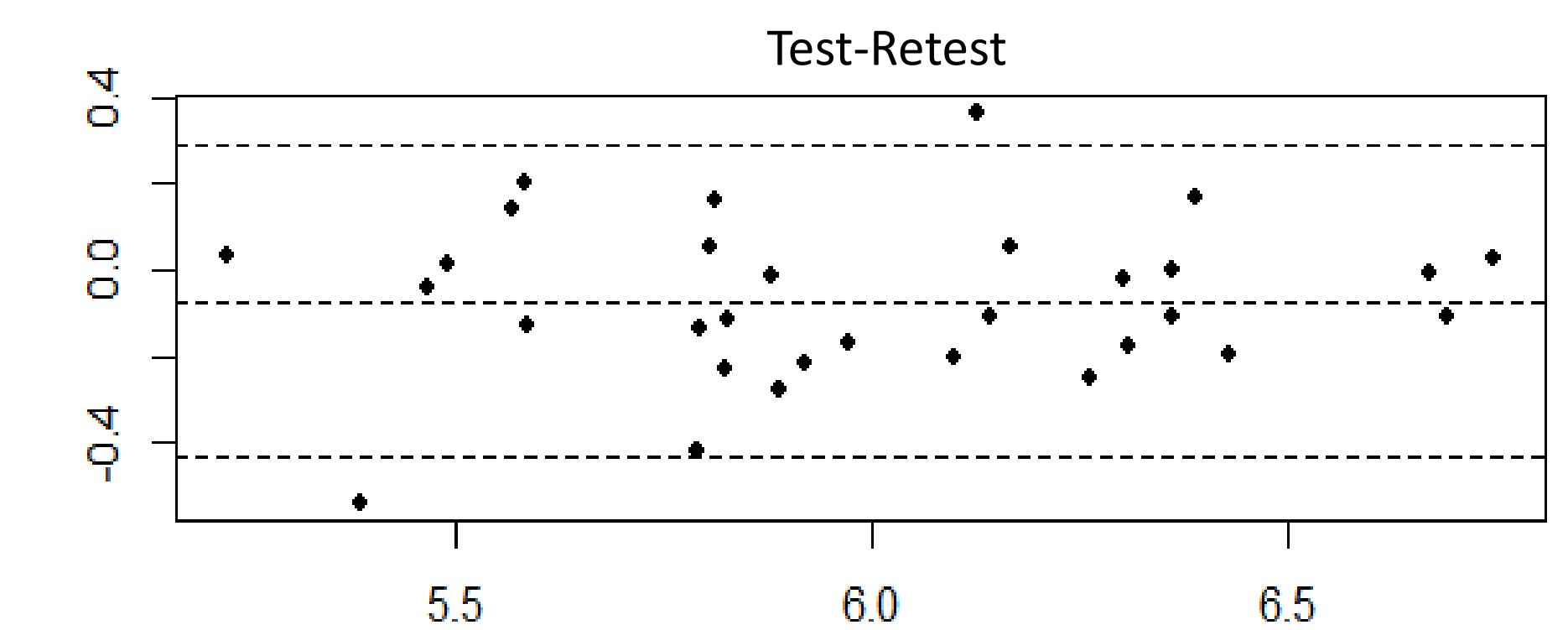
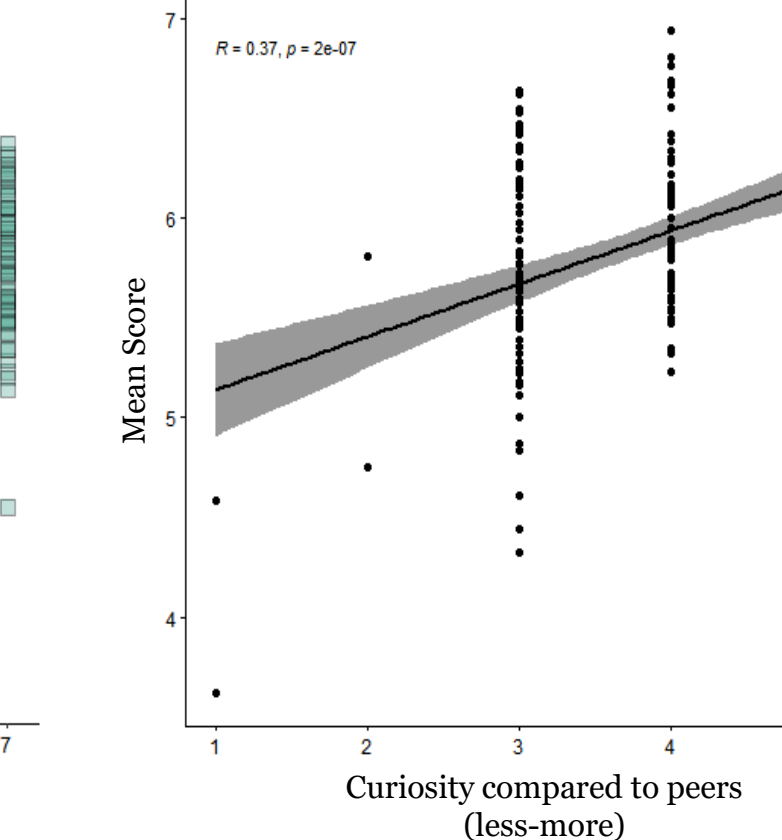
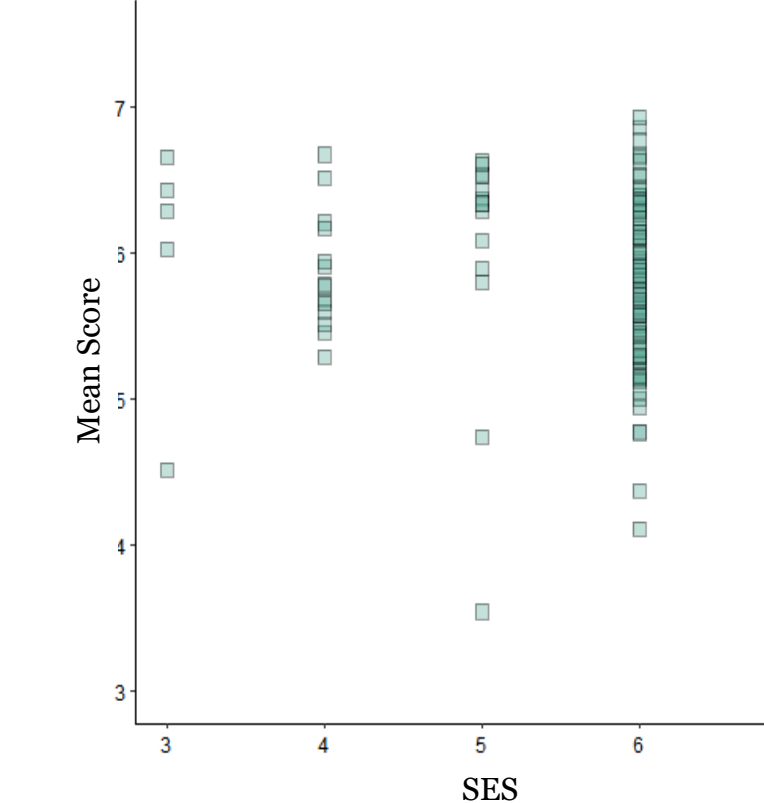
## 2. Is it any good? – Yes!



**Sample**  
N = 197,  $M_{age} = 13.63$  (4.9 – 24.8)  
50.8% female

**Retest** (7-14 days later):  
N = 31,  $M_{age} = 12.57$  (5.5 – 24.21)  
58% female

Cronbach's  $\alpha = .90$   
Test-retest: ICC2 = 0.89\*\*\*
